Question

Can VEE Software Upgrade Offline (Without the Internet)?

Answer

Yes. Download the VEE 9.33 installation file from any PC with an internet connection and copy that file and install it on that PC without an internet connection. The only problem is that VEE 9.33 would require .NET Framework 3.5 Service Pack 1 to be installed on that PC first. So during VEE's installation, it will detect if the PC has the .NET 3.5 SP1 present, else it would request for the user to download and install, which can be done automatically if the PC is connected to the internet. If that targeted PC does not have .NET Framework 3.5 SP1 installed, download it from Microsoft's website and install it manually on that PC prior to installing VEE.
