VEE: Can I access HP VEE from another programming environment?

HP VEE 4.X and 5.X could be accessed from environments like Visual Basic and C/C++ through Object Linking and Embedding (OLE). The details on doing this are documented in a separate HP VEE help file - Call.hlp. Call.hlp is installed under the HP VEE install directory. Call.hlp and OCX files only ship with the full developer version of HP VEE. HP VEE 6.X will provide true support as an ActiveX Automation Server; allowing HP VEE 6.X to be called from other environments.
